Duties and function of the Organisations:

1. The organisation shall maintain an appropriate administrative structure and a duly constituted managing committee. Any change in managing committee shall be intimated within a month of approval by the Registrar of Society.
2. The organization shall lay its activities in the form of by-laws and any deletion or inclusion in by-laws to be intimated within one month of approval by Registrar of Society.
3. The description and details of the type of animal welfare activities which an organisation will undertake must be mentioned in the aims and objectives of the organization alongwith the jurisdiction of the work.
4. The organisation shall accept homeless / rescued/ treated / diseased / old animals from the local bodies / individuals / organization, local bodies individuals, organisations research institution for rehabilitation upon receiving the direction of Board, subject to the availability of the space and capacity of the organisation.
5. The organisation must cooperate with and co-ordinate the work of local bodies or State Animal Welfare Board or SPCA established for the purpose of preventing unnecessary pain or suffering to animals or for the protection of animals and birds;
6. To impart education in relation to the humane treatment of animals and to encourage the formation of public opinion against the infliction of unnecessary pain or suffering to animals and for the promotion of animal's welfare by means of lectures, books, posters, exhibitions and the like.
7. **This recognition is not valid for ABC programme for which separate permission need to be obtained as per extant ABC Rules.**

Additionally, the recognized organizations, having adequate facilities shall provide the following services:-

1. To provide veterinary treatment to injured and sick animals.
2. To provide ambulance service to the animals in distress.
3. To carryout immunization and sterilization of stray dogs according to the Animal Birth Control (Dogs) Rules, 2009.
4. To provide care and protection to the stray and diseased/uncared animals particularly in times of natural calamities such as cyclone, flood, drought, famine, forest/village fires, earthquakes, landslides, heavy snowfall, hailstorm, epidemics and any other unforeseen circumstances.
5. The organizations shall not inspect or trespassed or confiscate any animals from any establishment, unless is directed by the Board or any other authority.

Maintenance of record:

1. Each Organisation shall maintain the records of 5 years in the manner and format prescribed by the Board.
2. Each organisation shall-
 - (a) To submit, at the end of each year, a report to the Board, consisting of the information as to the total number of animals rescued, rehabilitated, treated, operated and send for adoption, every year;
 - (b) To submit, at the end of each year, such information regarding source of income, animal welfare activities, Audited accounts and Annual Report to the Board every year;

Power to inspect:

1. The Board shall depute inspection authority to inspect any organization as and when necessary.
2. The Inspection Authority shall, have power to—
 - (a) To enter into the organisation at any reasonable time and access to all areas within the organisation and all animals, and records, to ascertain whether the requirements of these rules are being complied with;
 - (b) To take pictures, record videos, and make copies of the records.
3. The Inspection Authority shall submit their report to the Board.

Non -Compliance of the guidelines by organisation:

1. If the Board, after considering the inspection report is of the opinion that any requirements are contravened by the organisation, it may, after giving a copy of the report to the organisation and an opportunity to show cause, revoke the certificate of recognition in respect of that organisation and communicate the reasons thereof in writing.
2. The Board based on the inspection report may take action in accordance with this Act or any other law for the time being in force.

Renewal of recognition:

1. An Application for renewal of recognition shall be submitted to the Board, forty days prior to the expiry of the recognition of the Organization in a manner prescribed by the Board.
2. The fees of Rs. 5000/- for renewal of recognition shall be paid to the Board alongwith the application of renewal.
